Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 - POP Regulation

The "Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council of June 20, 2019 on persistent organic pollutants" (POP Regulation) prohibits the production, placing on the market and use of persistent organic pollutants.

TR Electronic GmbH hereby confirms that no substances listed in Annex I - prohibited substances - and Annex II - restricted substances - are used in the manufacture of its own products and any associated assembly work.

As part of the supply chain, we are also in close contact with our suppliers with regard to their procedures for handling POP substances.

According to the information available to us, the products of our suppliers and sub-suppliers do not contain any POP substances in accordance with Annex I or II of the aforementioned regulation.
